Note: Where there are two catalogue numbers for a particular record, one number is likely for a mono version of the recording, and the larger number is usually a stereo version. There is believed to be a second "Souvenir Album," but info on it is not available, as Johnny cannot even locate a copy of his own. Not all records are new recordings; many are re-issues. Many single records were used on LP, and also vice-versa. All CDs are re-releases except "Song That Made The Flappers Cry" (recorded 1978) and "Cowboys & Indians" (recorded 1984). Crazy Otto Music is in the process of reissuing recordings of Johnny, so there will probably be more CDs released. He is also recording two new albums for release on CD in honor of his 80th birthday.
