

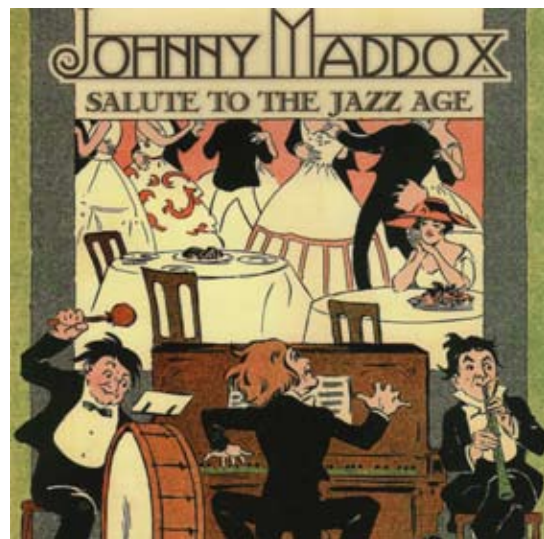

A jam session teaming Johnny Maddox with Vern Baumer, a master clarinetist who has played with Lawrence Welk's Big Tiny Little and is a co-founder of the acclaimed Denver group New Orleans Jazz Gathering. On this release, originally recorded in 1978, the pair put their distinctive stamp on a diverse selection of tunes from the Jazz Age, F. Scott Fitzgerald's name for the halcyon days between World War I and the Great Depression. Comprising folk, ragtime, blue, jazz, and Tin Pan Alley, this is the music Gatsby and Daisy would have been listening to by the pool. Included are versions of such favorites as "Honeysuckle Rose," the bittersweet "Do You What It Means To Miss New Orleans," and Mamie Smith's "Crazy Blues," the first blues song ever recorded.

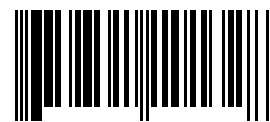
